

Pastor's Weekly Devotional- June 25, 2015

"The Love of God"

I once overheard a conversation between a father and his children. One of the children was admonishing another: "You must be good or father won't love you." Calling the boy to him, the father said: "Son, that isn't really true."

"But you won't love us if we are bad, will you?" the boy asked.

"Yes, I will love you whether you are good or bad. There is a difference in my love. When you are good, I will love with a love that makes me glad; but when you are not good, I will love you with a love that hurts me."

This incident reminds me of God's love. God's love is incomprehensible. He loves everyone. In fact, the Bible says that "He (God) is not willing anyone should perish..." Here is how God's love is expressed in John 3:16.

"So loved".....The Greatest Degree
"The World".....The Greatest Number
"That He gave".....The Greatest Act
"His only begotten Son".....The Greatest Gift
"That whosoever".....The Greatest Invitation
"Should not perish".....The Greatest Deliverance
"But".....The Greatest Difference
"Have".....The Greatest Certainty
"Everlasting Life".....The Greatest Possession
