“Insignificant Things”

If ever you read the biographies of men and women who have accomplished great things, one fact that stands out is that most of them were not born with “a silver spoon in their mouths” but came from total obscurity to achieve popularity.

The scripture is filled with instances where God used seemingly insignificant and unimportant people to carry out great tasks.

For instance:

★ In Egypt, God brought together a mother's heart and a baby's cry in a crocodile-infested river, for the baby Moses to be found. As a result, God changed the destiny of a nation.

★ In the Book of Esther, the king had a sleepless night. It seemed to be small thing but God was laying the groundwork for the protection of His people.
